


#### Balcombe Camp

In partnership with the Raleigh Estate, Young Spirit have built a comfortable fixed camp.













#### In the spirit of bushcraft

When constructing our site, we took care to use materials we found in the woods for the main elements:


- We harvested mainly Japanese Larches, a commercial crop tree and a good long lasting timber.
- We used the entire tree, off cuts for logs and chipping smaller pieces for floors and paths.
- We use a small mobile sawmill to cut down on transport













What are we here for ?;



#### Clothes to wear

- •Trousers, jogging bottoms or
- •similar preferably not jeans x 1 (maybe shorts!!!)
- •T-shirt x1
- •Jumper/ fleece x1
- Socks x1
- •Wellies are best or suitable boots or
- trainers with good soles. (it can be very muddy when wet)

#### In a bag suitable for carrying

- Sun cream
- •Warm hat or sun hat
- Packed lunch
- Drinks bottle
- •Waterproof coat (and trousers if possible)

Bedding, overnight and camping kit

- Packed and sealed in a separate thick double bin bags and labelled
- 1x pair trousers, 1x T-shirt, 1x warm top, 1x pair socks. Underwear
- Trainers, crocs or sandals, for camp
- Swimming costume
- Sleeping bag or duvet (it is possible that all items taken will get damp and dirty) We can hire sleeping bags for a sma fee
- Pillow case,
- Warm nightwear
- Towel
- Toothbrush
- Personal items a soft toy, a book, camera etc (electronic games, mp3s and mobile phones are not encouraged)
- Medication if carried
- Small torch
- Packet of anti bacterial wipes
- Spoon and plastic mug, bowl
