ACTIVATE CURIOSITY:

Anglo-Saxon afternoon- create an Anglo-Saxon village, explore Anglo-Saxon food, Anglo-Saxon jewellery and decipher messages using Runes.

ENGLISH- Innovate
Children to write their own quest story based on Arthur and the Golden Rope.

MUSIC: Harvest Festival

SCIENCE: The invention of toothpaste. What were the first toothpastes like? How do they get toothpaste in to tubes? Which do you think is better for our teeth- modern toothpaste or the first toothpaste?

History

The children will learn about who the Anglo-Saxons [and Scots, briefly] were, where they came from, why they moved, where they settled [with a local emphasis], how they lived, how we know, how and why Totnes came to be, and what life might have been like in the flourishing Saxon burh.

Non-Fiction- How to be an Anglo-Saxon in 13 easy steps.

RE theme: What do Christians learn from the creation story?

Butterflies Class Autumn 1st Half Term

Geography: Why did the Anglo Saxons choose to settle along our river Dart? What can we learn from maps and place-names? What were their settlements like? How did they use the land and how has land use changed today? What was Anglo-Saxon Totnes like?

ENGLISH- Invent
Children to write a quest. Chn to include a questor, challenges and magical items to collect. Children to write an information text.

SCIENCE

Animals including humans:
Chn will learn to:

- Describe the simple functions of the basic parts of the digestive system in humans
- Identify the different types of teeth in humans and their simple functions.

MATHS

Place Value: Comparing, ordering and rounding numbers to 1000. Count in 50's, 25's and 1000's. Finding more/ less.
Addition and Subtraction: up to 4 digit numbers.

ART

Facial expressions in drawing inspired by Arthur and the Golden Rope. Chn to explore using colour/ pencil/ ink to create a facial expression in their drawing.
