

Maths

Year 1

- Addition and subtraction: Within 20
- Place value: Within 50
- Length and Height
- Mass and Volume

Year 2

- Multiplication and Division
- Length and Height
- Mass, capacity and temperature

DT

In DT children will look at how to join fabrics together using pins, staples and glue. They will design, make and evaluate their own puppet.

English

Non-Fiction – *What do you do with a tail like this?*

To create your own 'What do we do with...' book.

Poetry – *A First Book of Poetry*

To perform a poem as part of a class. To write a poem using ideas from the models provided.

Science

In Science, children will learn that animals have offspring that grow into adults and describe what this looks like in a range of animals. Children will know the basic needs that must be satisfied for animals to survive.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring the question: 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?'

PE

In PE, we will be developing our object control and striking.

PSHE

In PSHE, children will be focusing on the topic 'Healthy Me.' We will be looking at healthy food, how to have healthy relaxed minds and how to be safe around medicine.

Historically important place


We will study Britain's largest prison and think about why it was built in the middle of Devon.
