Science

In Science, children will identify and name a variety of common plants and trees. They will learn about the differences between evergreen and deciduous trees and make observations of plants and how they change over time. Children will continue to observe changes across the seasons and how the day length varies.

RE

In RE, children will answer the question, *How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?*

PE

In PE, we will be improving our athletic skills and we will use these for our sports day races.

PSHE

Our PSHE unit is 'Changing Me'. We will explore some of the changes that will happen to our bodies as we grow up. We will learn how to respect our bodies and how to cope with change.

History

In History children will explore an event beyond living memory and its significance. Children will identify, recognize, describe and suggest reasons for the way people lived in the city of Pompeii. They will use historical evidence to describe what happened in Pompeii and suggest reasons about how we know so much about what happened in Pompeii.

DT

In DT children will select fruits and vegetables. They will prepare food by cutting and juicing to create a smoothie to meet a design brief.


English
