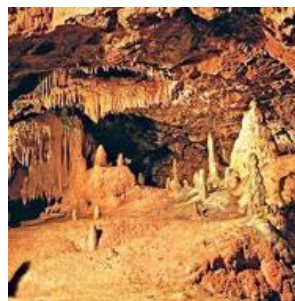


Stones, Bones & Bumps – STOKE GABRIEL

Activate Curiosity We will become historians, exploring the evidence left behind by those who were here before. Pre-history makes up the majority of all history, but what do we really know?

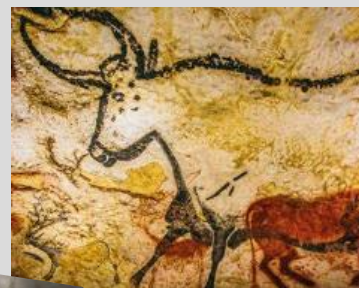

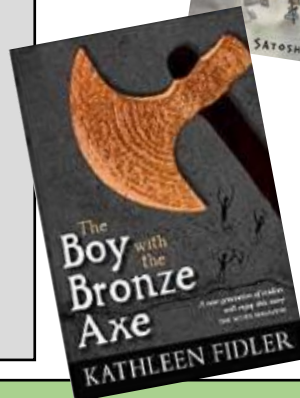

Maths

Year 3 and 4 are focusing on Subtraction and Additional initially this half term.

Then, we will begin our ongoing unit of multiplication and division.



PE

In PE we will be learning about gymnastics and how to transition smoothly, while making shapes with our bodies.

History and Geography

We will be looking at changes in Britain from the Stone Age, through to the end of the Iron Age and develop an understanding of the term 'prehistory'. We will be looking at sources of evidence and using these to draw conclusions.

Stone Age: Palaeolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic periods; hunter gatherers; nomadic lifestyle; early farmers; study Kents Cavern and Skara Brae.

Bronze Age: development of farms and settlements, use of metal, domestication of animals; trade.

Iron Age: roundhouses found on Dartmoor; hill forts; weapons.
